CITY LINK

BUS STOPS

The City Link buses will stop at designated bus stops only if passengers are waiting at the stops. It is recommended you arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes early to ensure you do not miss the bus. Buses will not come back for you. Times may vary due to traffic.

Pull the Stop Cord one block before you want to de-board. Buses may deviate to another designated stop on their route for drop offs if the driver deems the schedule will allow it, and only if the driver deems safe to do so. Passengers may hail a bus en-route by standing on the right side of the street and raising a hand. Buses will only stop where deemed safe (no intersections, four lane streets or highways).

TRANSFERS

Upon request, the driver will issue a transfer ticket that allows a direct transfer to another City Link Route. The transfer is free, but must be used within the hour. It may not be used to reach a second destination or as a return ticket on the route from which it was issued.

HALF-FARE ELIGIBILITY

Passengers 60+, Disabled or Low-Income may apply for a Half-Fare Discount Card by completing the Half-Fare application and attaching required verifications. The Half-Fare Card and photo ID must be presented upon boarding to receive the Half-Fare Discount. Students show current Student ID to receive discount.

MINI BUS PARATRANSIT ELIGIBILITY

Persons who are certified under ADA as having a disability that prevents them from being able to ride City Link buses are eligible to use the Mini Bus ADA Paratransit Service. A completed application must be approved to utilize this service. Applications are available at the FIT office or on our website. Call the FIT office to schedule an appointment up to two weeks in advance of the preferred date and time. Fare is \$1.00 per person per one-way trip within Garden City city-limits. Add \$1.00 per 5 mile increment beyond city-limits.

Information for Riders

RULES OF THE ROAD

- Passengers are responsible for all personal belongings. Drivers are not permitted to assist passengers with loading or unloading of packages. No furniture or appliances.
- Only packages that will fit under your seat and out of the aisle are allowed.
- Due to time limitations, please transport only what you are able to carry on or off in one trip. Passengers must load their own bikes.
- Walking aids, strollers and empty shopping carts must be collapsed and out of the aisle.
- No smoking, eating or drinking on the bus.
- Inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated.
- No open containers, weapons, ammunition or hazardous materials (gasoline, propane, car batteries, etc.) are allowed on the bus.
- Only trained service animals are allowed.
- In the event of inclement weather, if USD 457 or the Senior Center of Finney County closes, the bus service will be closed.
- Check radio/TV for weather related closings.
- Complete guidelines available on request.

*Children 10 and under must be accompanied by someone 16 or older. Children between the ages of 11 and 16 must provide a photo ID when boarding the bus. Children ages 5 and under may ride free with another paying passenger.

**To receive the Half-Fare Senior/Disabled/Low Income Discount, a completed Half-Fare Discount Application must be submitted and approved. Applications are available at the FIT office or on-line. You must present Half-Fare Discount card and picture ID upon boarding.

**Students receive Half-Fare Discount by presenting their current Student ID.

***Punch Cards and Monthly Passes are non-refundable and non-replaceable. Passes are non-transferable. You must present picture ID when boarding bus with Monthly Pass.

Exact Fares must be paid in cash, FIT Token(s), Monthly Pass, or a FIT Punch Card. These may be purchased at the FIT Office or by mailing a check or money order. **Drivers do not carry change.**
